Seddon Shield Area Competitions

Matthewson Trophy - Interclub Digital Projected Image Competition

- An entry in this competition shall be made by a Club or Society only, and shall consist of six digital projected images.
- Not more than two images in each entry may be made by any one member of that Club or Society.
- The sets should be judged as individual exhibition works, with the club entry gaining the highest aggregate being the winner.
- It is not meant to be a club set where a common theme or balance of work is required.
- Photos entered in the Matthewson Trophy cannot be entered as duplicate entries in the open/landscape/natural history section, or the Geoffrey C Woods competitions.

Competitions for Individual Members

Geoffrey C Wood Trophy

- The competition is for individual members and shall consist of a portfolio of six photos.
- The portfolio should show the ability, competence and skills of the photographer.
- The portfolio will consist of six prints on even years and six projected images on odd years.
- The total entry should demonstrate your diversity of expertise.
- Photos entered in the Geoffrey C Woods cannot be entered as duplicate entries in the open/landscape/natural history section, or Matthewson Trophy competitions.

Open/Landscape/Natural History

- No Novice entries in this section
- Open to individual members who may have a total of up to 6 entries in the combined sections.
- Each entry may be in any combination of prints/projected images to make a combined total of six (6) or less.
For example an entry may be:
6 prints open or 6 projected images open
2 prints open, plus 2 projected images open, plus 2 natural history.
- The natural history competition is judged as a separate competition but the landscape award is selected from the open section.
- Photos entered in the Open/Landscape/Natural History cannot be entered as duplicate entries in the Geoffrey C Woods, or Matthewson Trophy competitions.

Novice Section (Open only)

- Entrant must never have previously entered a Seddon Shield competition.
- Must not have previously won any major photographic competitions.
- Must be identified as a Novice
- Must have been a member of their Club for less than two years.
- Other conditions as for Open/Landscape/Natural History above

Webber Memorial Natural History (Overall Champion Award)

- The competition is for New Zealand natural history.
- Examples of New Zealand natural history include:
 - ❖ Animal life - Native animals, birds, insects, animal tracks, nests, marine life, etc, but NOT domestic or mounted specimens.
 - ❖ Plant life - Flowers (not formal arrangements), trees, shrubs, ferns, fungi etc.
 - ❖ Photomicrography - In connection with biological and geological subjects.
 - ❖ General - Scenery with a specific aspect, geology, clouds meteorological interest etc.
 - ❖ Naturalised subjects - e.g. deer, black swan, monarch butterfly, wild briar (NOT cultivated roses).

Seddon Shield Area Photographic Meeting

General Conditions of Entry to Competitions (Please Read Carefully)

Eligibility: Open to all members of Camera Clubs or Societies in Nelson, Marlborough and West Coast areas.

Processing: Entries may be trade processed but must have been exposed by the entrant.

Presentation: **Prints** may be of any size, provided that the mount does not exceed a minimum of 400sq.cm (25 x 18cm or 9" x 7"), and a maximum of 2000sq.cm (50 x 40cm or 20" x 16"), or any shape that does not exceed these dimensions.

Note: Framed and/or glass covered prints will not be accepted.

Slides must be in mounts 5 x 5cm. They may be mounted between glass, but will only be accepted if thin enough for projection in a modern projector (e.g. carousel)

Digital Images shall be submitted as JPEG files only, sized no more than 1024 pixels wide or 768 pixels high and presented on a CD.

The term "Projected Image" refers to Digital Images and 35mm Slides.

Identification: **Prints** the photographers name, address, club, section entered and number (to correspond with the entry Form), plus the title of the print, is to all appear on the reverse at "Top Centre" of the print.

Slides must be spotted in the bottom left-hand corner in their hand-held position. The title must be visible on the spotted side. On the reverse side must appear the makers name, address, and club.

Digital Images must have a title and number to correspond with the same on the entry form. The name of the entrant should appear on the front of the CD only

Duplication: Photos can no longer be entered as duplicate entries in more than one of the of the Seddon Shield competitions.
Eg. A photo entered in the open/natural history section, is now, not eligible to be entered in the Geoffrey C Wood or Matthewson Trophy competitions (and vice versa).

Disqualification: The host club has the right to disqualify any image that does not comply with the rules here stated.

Damage or Loss: The hosting club will take all reasonable care of entries, but cannot accept responsibility for entries damaged or lost.

Return of Entries: These will be returned via a member(s) of your club who are attending the weekend meets, or you may elect to have them returned via post or Courier Post by including the return postage or courier ticket with your entries.

Engraving of Trophies: This is the responsibility of the host club. Please ensure trophies are recalled one month prior to meeting. N.B. Judging results should be in hand allowing time for the engraving.

Competition Results: A copy to be made by the host club and given to all clubs involved. Results plus an account of the weekend's activities are to go to Camera Talk. This account could also go to local newspapers, (don't forget photos).

Awards:

Geoffrey C Wood Trophy

The winner of this competition shall receive a certificate and be entitled to hold the trophy for the ensuing year, returning it to the next host club on request the following year.

Matthewson Trophy (Interclub Competition)

The club placed first in this competition shall be entitled to hold the trophy for the ensuing year, returning it to the next host club on request.

- Overall Champion Natural History Print/Projected Image,

Ellis Dudgeon Landscape

- Overall Champion Landscape Print/Projected Image

Seddon Shield Area Open Champion

- Overall Champion Open Print/Projected Image

The winning photographs of each section, and overall Champions, will receive Award Certificates ('Honours' & 'Merits'), awarded at the judge's discretion. The judge's decisions are final, and no correspondence will be entered into.
