Meetings are held on the 3rd Tuesday of each month at 7:30pm (February to December) in the RSA Bowling Club Rooms, 181 Tainui Street (between Century 21 Real Estate and Guthrie Bowron).

The club offers members the following:

- **Monthly meetings** offering a range of programmes including practical sessions, covering many topics from the basics of camera use through to the more advanced use of digital photography software, and guest speakers of varying photographic interests.
- **Monthly competitions** which are a good way to both showcase your photographs and learn from the judges comments. They also provide an opportunity to view and be inspired by work from fellow photographers.
- **Field trips** to some great West Coast sites where you have the opportunity to capture many wonderful images.
- **Workshops** covering various topics subject to demand and interest. Members are encouraged to ask for workshops to be held on any matter they wish to learn more about.
- **Monthly newsletters** containing news, articles, competition results, photography and helpful hints.
- **Access to our extensive club library** of photographic resources.
- **Free entry in the annual Seddon Shield Area Photographic Competitions** which are organised in turn by each of the five photography clubs in the West Coast, Buller, Nelson and Marlborough regions.
- **Club affiliation to the Photographic Society of New Zealand**, providing members with benefits such as receiving PSNZ's monthly newsletter (CameraTalk), access to PSNZ Help Sheets and the opportunity to apply for photographic honours to the level of Licentiate (LPSNZ). The affiliation also keeps our club up-to-date with the latest photographic news, events and competitions from around New Zealand.
- **Above all else, the meetings offer an opportunity to meet and share experiences with other photographers.**
