## PHOTOJOURNALISM AWARD

### ◆ The Ede Cup ◆

#### COMPETITION RULES

- 1 **Competition:** The competition shall be for Photojournalism prints and/or digital photographs.
- 2 **Definition:** Photojournalism is defined as follows –

*Photojournalism entries shall consist of pictures or sequences with informative content and emotional impact, including human interest, sports, documentary and spot news. The journalistic value of the photograph shall be considered over pictorial value. In the interest of credibility, photographs which misrepresent the truth, such as manipulation to alter the subject matter, or situations which are set up for the purpose of photography, are unacceptable in Photojournalism competition.*
- 3 **Number of Entries:** Entrants may submit up to a maximum of **two** photographs.
- 4 **Exposure Date of Entries:** Entries must have been taken within 24 months prior to the date of the competition.
- 5 **Eligibility:** Any photograph previously receiving an award in this competition is not eligible.
- 6 **Presentation:** **Prints** may be of any size, to a maximum of **500mm x 400mm (20" x 16")**, including the mount. Framed or glass-covered prints will not be accepted.

**Digital** images must be sized, named and saved in accordance with the following guidelines:

  - Size images to a maximum of **1024 pixels** wide and **768 pixels** high.
  - Images must be saved in **JPEG** format.
  - Embedding a colour profile is recommended (for viewing on monitors this is usually **sRGB**).
  - For identification and sorting purposes, image files must be **named** as follows: PJ ID [space] Title (eg: PJ123 Winning Image.jpg)
  - **Label your CD or USB Flash Disk** with your name **OR**
  - **Email your entry** to competitions@greymouthphotoclub.org.nz.
- 9 **Judging:** A judge known to be competent in the field of Photojournalism shall be selected and he/she shall be given a copy of these rules with the entries.
- 10 **Awards:** **The Greymouth Photography Club Photojournalism Award** shall be awarded for the best Photojournalism photograph. The winner shall receive a certificate and be entitled to hold the trophy for one year.

**Second and Third** places shall also be awarded, the recipients each receiving certificates.

**Highly Commended** places shall be awarded at the judge's discretion, but shall not comprise of more than 10% of the total number of entries. The recipients shall each receive a certificate.

**Merits** shall be awarded at the judge's discretion, but shall not comprise of more than 10% of the total number of entries. The recipients shall each receive a certificate.

- 11 **Points:** Points shall be given for photographs gaining the awards listed in Rule 10 and will count towards the member's total points in the Aggregate Points competition. The value of points shall be:

First Place	3 points
Second Place	2 points
Third Place	2 points
Highly Commended	1 point
Merit	1 point
