The Fensom Cup ♦ The Gifford Cup Champion Monochrome Trophy

COMPETITION RULES

- 1 **Competition:** The competition shall be for prints, slides and/or digital photographs having been awarded an Acceptance, Merit or Honours in club competition during the current year.
- 2 **Number of Entries:** Entrants may submit up to a maximum of **six** photographs.
- 3 **Eligibility:** Photographs must have been awarded an Acceptance, Merit or Honours in Greymouth Photography Club monthly competitions during the current year.
- 4 **Duplication:** An image shall only be entered in one medium (print, slide or digital file).
- 5 **Processing:** Entries may be trade processed, but must have been exposed by the entrant.
- 6 **Presentation:** **Prints** may be of any size, to a maximum of **500mm x 400mm (20" x 16")**, including the mount. Framed or glass-covered prints will not be accepted.
Slides must be spotted in the lower left-hand corner in their hand-held position. The title must be visible on the spotted side.
Digital images entered on a CD must be sized, named and saved in accordance with the following guidelines:
 - Size images to a maximum of **1024 pixels** wide and **768 pixels** high.
 - Images must be saved in **JPEG** format.
 - Embedding a source ICC colour profile is recommended (for viewing on monitors this is usually **sRGB**).
 - For identification and sorting purposes, image files must be **named** as follows: CC ID - Title (eg: CC 123 - Winning Image.jpg)
 - **Label your CD and CD case** with your name.
- 7 **Judging:** A judge known to be competent in photography shall be selected and he/she shall be given a copy of these rules with the entries.

8 **Awards:** **The Fensom Cup** shall be awarded for the best print. The winner shall receive a certificate and be entitled to hold the trophy for one year.

The Gifford Cup shall be awarded for the best projected image (slide or digital). The winner shall receive a certificate and be entitled to hold the trophy for one year.

The Champion Monochrome Trophy shall be awarded for the best monochrome (black & white) photograph (print or projected). The winner shall receive a certificate and be entitled to hold the trophy for one year.

Second and Third places shall also be awarded (for each trophy), the recipients each receiving certificates.

Highly Commended places shall be awarded at the judge's discretion, but shall not comprise of more than 10% of the total number of entries. The recipients shall each receive a certificate.

Merits shall be awarded at the judge's discretion, but shall not comprise of more than 10% of the total number of entries. The recipients shall each receive a certificate.

9 **Points:** Points shall be given for photographs gaining the awards listed in Rule 8 and will count towards the member's total points in the Aggregate Points competition. The value of points shall be:

Champion	3 points
Second Place	2 points
Third Place	2 points
Highly Commended	1 point
Merit	1 point
